Josip Pasic M.D. will speak on the brain/mind dilemma; awareness; current scientific explorations into the hard-wiring of the brain; our addiction to experience; and, issues of life beyond consciousnesses. Dr. Pasic is a Chicago based psychiatrist, Krishnamurti scholar, university professor, and prolific author and lecturer.

Hosts: R. E. Mark Lee is a trustee of the Krishnamurti Foundations of America and India; Asha Lee M.D. is a retired physician; Diane White is a theatrical producer.

Pine Cottage: Krishnamurti's home in America, is the venue of the inquiry. Adjacent is the Pepper Tree Retreat where all meals will be taken and up to fifteen participants can stay over the weekend. The opening orientation begins at Pine Cottage on Friday, April 1st at 6:30pm with refreshments and the weekend ends on Sunday April 3rd at 4:15pm.
